

RSS Information

Minimum Requirements:

In order for the RSS page to display correctly, you will need to have the latest version of Internet Explorer installed (version 7 or later). Mozilla Firefox, and Safari are also compatible as long as you are using the latest version.

What is RSS?

RSS (Really Simple Syndication) is an easy way to get the ShelbyPODCAST program whenever it is updated even if you are not on our ShelbyPODCAST web page. ShelbyPODCAST provides continually updated show feeds from all shows and delivers them directly to your web browser.

How can I use RSS?

Subscribing to the ShelbyPODCAST RSS Feed is quick and easy. Just click the **Subscribe to RSS** link on the ShelbyPODCAST web page or click the RSS icon on the IE7 Command Bar. Then click the **Subscribe to this feed** link from the RSS Subscription web page. Make sure the **Name** and **Create in:** fields are correct on the pop-up dialog box, and then click **Subscribe**. That's all there is to it!

Once the RSS reader is set up to access ShelbyPODCAST, it will continually poll the ShelbyPODCAST RSS feeds for the latest show streams. Now, you can find the latest show by opening your web browser, clicking **Favorites**, choosing **Feeds**, and then clicking on **ShelbyPODCAST**. Shows will be listed in the order they are released. All you need to do is click on the name of the show you would like to listen to, and it will start playing.

In addition, if you are using Office 2007, you will receive an email in your RSS folder each time there is a new ShelbyPODCAST available. See the example below. As you can see, RSS is an easy way to get all of the ShelbyPODCAST programs automatically delivered to you.
